Need for the training:

The government of India has recently launched its flagship programmes in the Water Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH) domain like Swachh Bharat Mission, AMRUT, Jal Jeevan Mission, among others, for both urban and rural areas of the country. Through these schemes, India is striving to achieve the targets set under SDG6, and others by focusing on complete coverage of piped water supply and holistic management of solid, liquid and fecal waste throughout the country.

For the first time, small towns (with less than 1 lakh population) and villages receive funds and solutions to tackle their sanitation challenges at par with larger cities. These programmes/ schemes envisage NGOs/ CBOs/ CSOs to form the necessary bridge between local governments and citizens, thereby taking forward the success of Jan-Andolan as an implementation strategy and hugely emphasise the role of NGOs/ CBOs/ CSOs in supporting local governments to plan and implement various components envisaged under the missions.

This **3-day workshop** is designed for organizations and individuals training in WASH to enhance their facilitation skills. Participants learn to effectively facilitate and adapt lessons on WASH, ensuring the relevance and appropriateness of training content.
